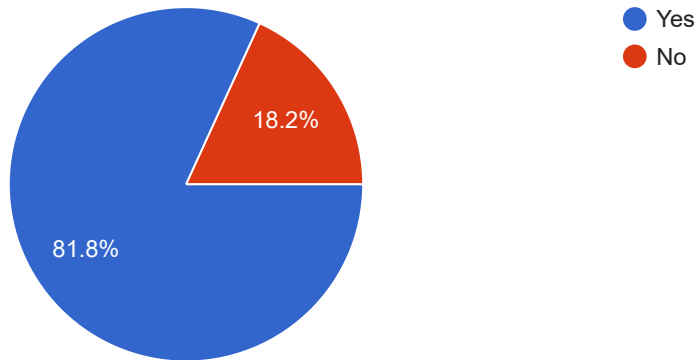

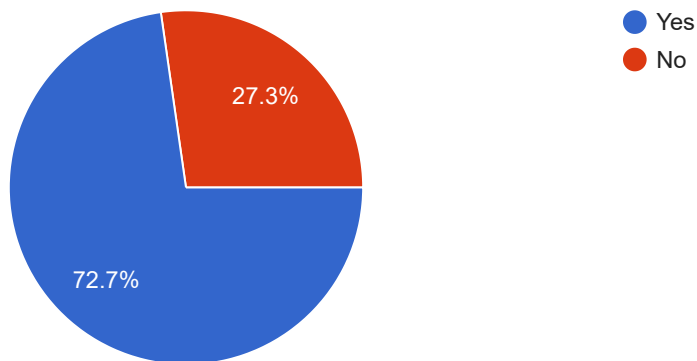
### Is the curriculum for student well designed?

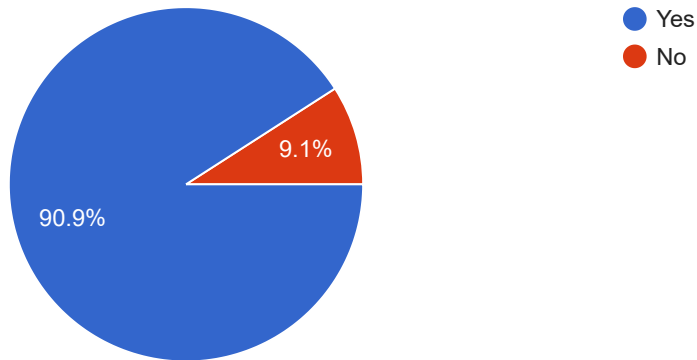
### Does the curriculum have enough content for a student to acquire sufficient knowledge to secure a subject related job?

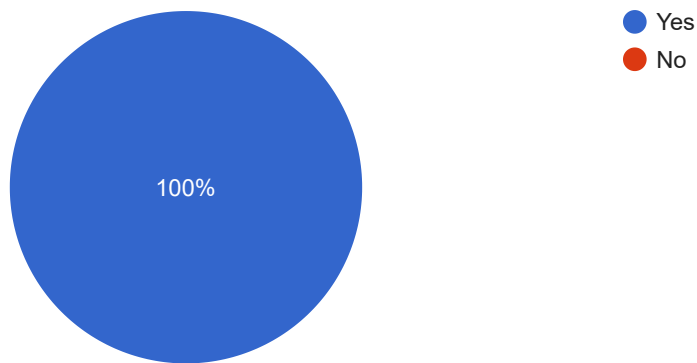
Does the curriculum promote student learning experience?

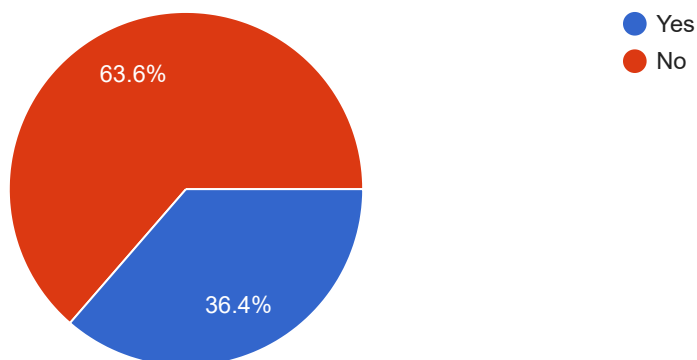
Does the course curriculum intellectually stimulate student?

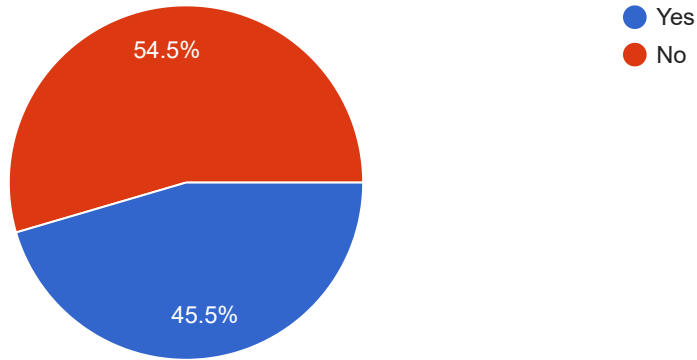
Does the curriculum design have focus on employ-ability?

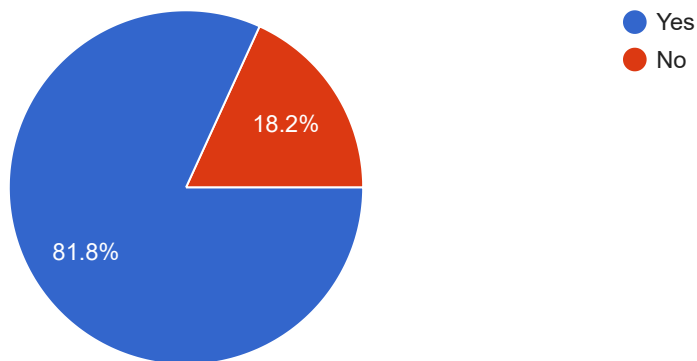
